

REQUEST FOR PERMISSION
TO MAKE SPECIAL APPEAL

Amended September 4, 1952

- Resolved: That at the request of the Board of Trustees of The American Church Institute for Negroes, permission is hereby given the Institute to launch a special appeal for One million, three hundred seventeen thousand, seven hundred and seventy-nine Dollars (\$1,317,779) for the restoration, development and equipment of the Church Institute's schools, and be it further
- Resolved: That while the division of capital requirements as reported herewith reflects the Institute's present judgment as to current needs of its schools and colleges, final division of the results of the appeal be entrusted to the Trustees of the Institute, and be it further
- Resolved: That the facilities of the Department of Promotion be made available to the Institute for this purpose, and that the Treasurer of the National Council be authorized to advance a sum not to exceed four percent (4%) of the total objective for all promotional purposes. All money so advanced to be repaid from the proceeds of the campaign.
