of the Presiding Bishop and Council. This motion was unanimously carried. The President appointed the Committee, as follows:

The session of the Presiding Bishop and Council adjourned at 1 p.m., until 3 p.m.

At 3 p.m. the Presiding Bishop and Council reconvened.

Mr. Franklin rose to present on behalf of the Committee on organization the new draft of the by-laws which had been returned to this Committee for reconsideration. With certain changes which the Committee accepted the remaining sections were each approved individually and upon motion duly seconded the by-laws as a whole were approved and adopted.

The President presented a request from the Woman's Auxiliary that it be reafter became the Woman's Auxiliary to the Presiding Bishop and Council rather than solely to the Department of Missions. It was suggested from the floor that this vital question be given very careful consideration.

The Bishop of Southern Chio, moved that the consideration of making a provision for the organization of women's work in the Church be referred to the Committee on Organization to report at the next meeting of the Council. This motion was adopted.

The President thereupon stated that he would advise the Woman's Auxiliary that this whole matter was receiving the earnest consideration of the Presiding Bishop and Council and that meanwhile the Presiding Bishop and Council most earnestly welcomed the continued cooperation of the Woman's Auxiliary.
